

Amana Academy 2009-2010 Dress Code Requirements

GIRLS

Bottoms (logos not required)	
Pants	KHAKI, NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Comparable to those available from the uniform vendors. Must be cotton twill with no outside pockets. Ankle length, no leg zippers or snaps, no tapered legs, no contrast topstitching. Cargo and corduroy pants are <u>not</u> permitted. Must fit correctly, not too loose or too tight. Belts should be worn if pants have belt loop. Sweat pants or jeans may not be worn.
Knee-Length Skorts	KHAKI, NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Comparable to those available from the uniform vendors. Must be worn to the top of the knee or longer. Must be cotton twill with no outside pockets. Cargo and corduroy skorts are <u>not</u> permitted. No exposed zippers or snaps, no pleats, no contrast topstitching.
Bike Shorts (K-3 rd)	NAVY, WHITE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plain, solid colors only. To be worn <u>under</u> jumper
Long Skirt (4 th -8 th)	KHAKI, NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Comparable to those available from the uniform vendors. Must be cotton twill with no outside pockets, no exposed zippers or snaps, no pleats, no contrast topstitching. Mid-calf or ankle length only.
Tops (logo required)	
<i>The Amana logo must be visible at all times on ALL garments listed below. To be purchased from French Toast and/or Uniform Depot ONLY.</i>	
Blouse	WHITE (S/S, L/S, or ¾ sleeve) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be worn <u>under</u> the jumper. If wearing short-sleeve blouse, no long-sleeve permitted under blouse.
Polo	WHITE, GREEN, LT. BLUE (S/S, L/S) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sleeves longer than wrist length are not allowed.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If wearing short-sleeve polo, no long-sleeve permitted under polo.
Jumper (K-3 rd only)	KHAKI, NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be worn to the top of the knee or longer
Sweater	NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sleeves longer than wrist length are unacceptable. Non-logoed sweaters will not be permitted in class.
Jacket	NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sleeves longer than wrist length are unacceptable. Non-logoed jackets will not be permitted in class.
Shoes and Socks	
Socks	WHITE only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Crew or knee socks only. Crew socks must reach above the ankle. No designs, accessories, beads or charms are allowed.
Tights	WHITE, NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Solid, full-toe only. Patterns, designs, appliqués are not allowed. Ankle-length leggings are not allowed.
Athletic Shoes (required for PE)	WHITE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Majority white shoes are permitted. No high tops, beads, patterns, or appliqués allowed. Shoes must be in good, clean condition and must be appropriate for running, jumping, and playing. Shoes must always be worn with socks that reach above the ankle (or tights.) Shoes must have a back (no clogs), and no open-toed sneakers or platforms are allowed. Heels should not exceed 1".
Dress Shoes	BLACK, NAVY, BROWN <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heels should not exceed 1". Heel/toe covering required. Shoes must have a back (no clogs), and no open-toed sandals or platforms are allowed. Approved styles include Mary Janes, Penny Loafers, Oxfords, etc.
Make-Up and Accessories	
<i>Please note: Anything that is a distraction to learning is not permitted and will be dealt with on an individual basis.</i>	
Belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be worn with pants/shorts that have belt loops. Plain black, navy or brown ONLY

Hats/Head Accessories/Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hats, bandanas and caps may not be worn indoors. • All other head coverings must conform to the following color and safety requirements – solid navy or solid white, with no patterns or accessories, no pins and must not hang down below the chest. • Headbands and hair ornaments are permitted in school colors only (lt. blue, white and hunter green).
Jewelry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All necklaces, rings, wrist watches, and bracelets should be simple enough not to distract from the learning. • Due to safety considerations, only stud earrings are permitted at school. • Sunglasses are for outside use only.
Make-Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make-up: Neutral colors only • Nail polish: clear or light colored only. • Due to student/staff member allergies, scented lotion, deodorant, cologne, or perfume is not allowed.

Boys

Bottoms (logos not required)	
Pants	KHAKI, NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comparable to those available from the uniform vendors. • Must be cotton twill with no outside pockets. • Ankle length, no leg zippers or snaps, no tapered legs, no contrast topstitching. • Cargo and corduroy pants are <u>not</u> permitted. • Must fit correctly, not too loose or too tight. • Belts should be worn if pants have belt loop. • Sweat pants or jeans may not be worn.
Knee-Length Shorts	KHAKI, NAVY (knee-length) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comparable to those available from the uniform vendors. • Must be worn to the top of the knee or longer. • Must be cotton twill with no outside pockets. • No leg zippers or snaps, no tapered legs, no contrast topstitching. • Cargo and corduroy shorts are <u>not</u> permitted. • Must fit correctly, not too loose or too tight. • Belts should be worn if shorts have belt loop.
Tops (logo required)	
<i>The Amana logo must be visible at all times on ALL garments listed below. To be purchased by French Toast and/or Uniform Depot ONLY.</i>	
Polo	WHITE, GREEN, LT BLUE (S/S, L/S) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sleeves longer than wrist length are unacceptable. • If wearing short-sleeve polo, long-sleeve not permitted under polo.
Sweater	NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sleeves longer than wrist length are not permitted. • Non-logoed sweaters will not be permitted in class.
Jacket	NAVY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sleeves longer than wrist length are unacceptable. • Non-logoed jackets will not be permitted in class.
Shoes and Socks	
Socks	WHITE, NAVY or BLACK <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crew socks only. • Solid colors only, no patterns, accessories or appliqués.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crew socks must reach above the ankle.
Athletic Shoes (required for PE)	<p>WHITE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Majority white shoes permitted. • No high tops, beads, patterns, or appliqués allowed. • Shoes must be in good, clean condition and must be appropriate for running, jumping, and playing. • Shoes must always be worn with socks that reach above the ankle (or tights.) • Shoes must have a back (no clogs), and no open-toed sneakers or platforms are allowed. • Heels should not exceed 1".
Dress Shoes	<p>BLACK, BROWN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Heels should not exceed 1". • Shoes must have a back (no clogs), and no open-toed sandals or platforms are allowed. • No hiking boots, patterns, or appliqués allowed. • Approved styles include Penny Loafers, Oxfords, etc.
Accessories	
<i>Please note: Anything that is a distraction to learning is not permitted and will be dealt with on an individual basis.</i>	
Belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be worn with pants/shorts that have belt loops. • Plain black, navy or brown ONLY
Hats/Head Accessories/Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hats, bandanas and caps may not be worn indoors. • All other head coverings must conform to the following color and safety requirements – solid navy or solid white, with no patterns or accessories, no pins and must not hang down below the chest.
Jewelry/Body Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All necklaces, rings, wrist watches, and bracelets should be simple enough not to distract from the learning. • Ear piercing is for girls only. No tattoos or piercings are allowed on other body parts. • Sunglasses are for outside use only.
Cologne/Scents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to student/staff member allergies, scented lotion, deodorant, cologne, or perfume is not allowed.

PE Uniform Requirements (optional)

Boys and Girls 6th-8th

<i>Middle school students have the option of changing out for PE, however, PE attire must conform to the following standards:</i>	
Official Amana PE T-shirt (logo required)	<p>LIGHT GREY (L/S, S/S)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be purchased from Uniform Depot only. • Sleeves longer than wrist length are unacceptable. • Non-logoed PE t-shirts are not permitted. • Students must change out for PE; PE t-shirt may not be worn on campus other than for PE.
Sweatshirt (logo required)	<p>NAVY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be purchased from Uniform Depot only. • Sleeves longer than wrist length are unacceptable. • Non-logoed PE sweatshirts are not permitted. • Students must change out for PE; PE sweatshirt may not be worn on campus other than for PE.
Athletic Shorts	<p>NAVY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comparable to those available from the uniform vendors. • Must be worn to the top of the knee or longer. • Must be mesh/nylon fabric with no outside pockets. • No zippers or snaps, no patterns, no appliquéés, no contrast topstitching. • Must fit correctly, not too loose or too tight.
Athletic Pants	<p>NAVY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comparable to those available from the uniform vendors. • Must be cotton blend fabric with no outside pockets. Leggings are <u>not</u> permitted. • No zippers or snaps, no patterns, no appliquéés, no contrast topstitching. • Must fit correctly, not too loose or too tight.

Out-of-Uniform Guidelines:

Out-of-uniform days are allowed on specific days during the academic year. On out-of-uniform days students are expected to be dressed appropriately and modestly.

- 1 Clothing must be clean and pants should be free of rips and tears.
- 2 Skirts and/or shorts must be worn no shorter than the top of knee.
- 3 Students are not allowed to wear tank tops, spaghetti strap tops, strapless tops, halter tops, mesh or see-through tops, beach shoes, flip-flops, backless shoes, sports sandals, short shorts, t-shirts/shirts which display advertisements for alcohol, cigarettes, or that uses inappropriate language.
- 4 The students' shoes on an out of uniform day must comply with the guidelines stated in the Amana Family Handbook. The heels of the shoes should not exceed 1 inch.
- 5 If a student has physical education on an out of uniform day, they must have shoes appropriate for the class.
- 6 Students are not allowed to wear hats indoors during the school day.
